It is forbidden to leave Brazil carrying wildlife forms and subproducts without Ibama's permit".

Federal Law nº. 9.605/98 and Decree nº 6.514/08



Importing or exporting animals, plants and their byproducts require Ibama's permit, regardless of other licenses.

Before travelling to Brazil, inform yourself about import or export authorizations required by Ibama:

- for plants, animals, their subproducts or parts, except for domestic ones, like dogs and cats;
- for genetically Modified Organisms, like GM seeds;
- for potentially polluting products, like pesticides, engines, tires and trash;
- for biological material for scientific use, like poisons, toxins and tissues.

Before leaving Brazil, check about import or export authorizations required by Ibama:

- for products or byproducts of flora, including non-timber forest ones, like orchids and bromeliads;
- for live or dead wild animals or their byproducts, like eggs, leather, fur, feathers and scales;
- for biological material for scientific use or product development;
- for ornamental fish and dead or alive aquatic invertebrates, like seahorses and corals.
